TIMETABLE

The event will follow this approximate time schedule:

Start: Kirroughtree Visitor Centre (DG8 7BE) @ **09.30 for 10.00 depart**
Please congregate in the small Car Park on the left which is next to the Main Car Park. The toilets and café will be open in the morning in case you feel peckish before the start.

Lunch Halt: The View, Port William, DG8 9QF @ **12.30-14.00**

Finish: Kirroughtree Visitor Centre (DG8 7BE) @ **around 15.30**

ROUTE

The route is about 100 miles measured on a normal vehicle trip meter and is defined by Tulip Diagrams and intermediate distances to 1/10th of a mile. It includes A, B and unclassified roads, however the majority of the mileage is on unclassified (yellow) roads. The route has been designed around a <30mph average so take your time and enjoy the views. Fuel stations and Public Toilets can be found on/near the route.
